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INTRODUCTION

The Impact We Wish to Deliver

- Integration, and increased retention of underprivileged students from transitional communities, into the public education system
- Improved health indices (body weight, height, BMI) through meal supplements and regular health check-ups
- Overall personality development through specialized learning programs

What We Do

- **Classroom teaching** in foundational subjects such as English, Hindi, Maths, EVS and Computer science – to reinforce concepts and help students “catch up” to their peers.
- **Nutritional support** with 1 meal a day with minimum of 500 calories, 8 grams of protein, and other vital nutrients.
- **Health check-ups** including anemia testing, immunization support, and eye check ups

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

Holistic development of the child:

- Foundational learning
- Promoting health & immunisation
- Providing nutritional support
- Extracurricular activities
- Safe space for social interaction

Our 'After-School Club' (ASC) program in Gurugram, Haryana, aims to supplement the functioning of the mainstream public education system for the transitional communities, by focusing on the following activities.

We work towards helping 'out of school children in developing the basic skills needed for them to be ready to take on formal learning in schools.

We also provide after-school support in the form of doubt clearance and reinforcement of key concepts for children who are already enrolled in government schools.

We essentially incentivise participation and involvement in learning through parent engagement and incentives like the provision of school supplies and learning aids, a meal supplement per day, as well as regular free health check-ups for the holistic development of our children.

ACADEMICS

Routine classes continued from October to end of December 24 ! The children came back from school full time after the half day extracurricular activities , with extra classes for catch up learning.



NUTRITION

Through our partnership with Feeding India, we are proud to provide our children with nutritious hot meals every day. This collaboration ensures that our students are well-nourished, promoting their overall well-being and enhancing their ability to learn and excel academically. Together, we are creating a healthier, more focused learning environment, enriched by moments of joy and celebration along the way.



EXERCISE AND PLAY

At Vision Unlimited's After-School Club, we emphasize the pivotal role of play and physical activity in nurturing children's overall development. Recognizing that movement is key to their holistic growth, we have integrated outdoor play and morning exercise as essential elements of our curriculum. These activities not only promote physical fitness but also enhance mental well-being, teamwork, and self-discipline.

Outdoor play offers children the opportunity to explore, interact, and develop their motor skills, while morning exercises instill energy and focus, setting a positive tone for the day. By seamlessly embedding these practices into their daily routine, we aim to cultivate a love for an active lifestyle and create a balanced environment where learning and play complement each other. At Vision Unlimited, we are committed to fostering well-rounded growth, ensuring every child thrives physically, mentally, and socially.



DAYCARE CENTER

Our After-School Clubs (ASCs) typically welcome children above the age of four. However, many of our older students are responsible for minding their younger siblings while their mothers work, preventing them from attending school.

To address this, we introduced a dedicated play area for children as young as two years old within our ASC. This initiative ensures that older siblings can continue their education without the burden of childcare. Currently, forty little ones are part of this play area, where they are engaged in a safe and nurturing environment.

Other ASCs have also joined this effort, providing support by caring for younger siblings during school hours. This approach not only promotes educational continuity for older children but also fosters an inclusive community. By addressing these challenges, we aim to empower families, ensuring no child misses out on learning opportunities due to caregiving responsibilities.



SPECIAL ABILITY PROGRAM

At our Club, we are committed to embracing children with special abilities and ensuring they feel a sense of belonging. Currently, we have 20 children in our clubs who face challenges due to physical, emotional, or intellectual limitations. To bridge this gap, our dedicated teachers visit these children at their homes twice a week.

During these visits, the teachers bring small treats and snacks to create a warm and encouraging atmosphere. They also engage the children in tailored educational activities, designed to cater to their unique needs and abilities. This personalized approach helps build their confidence, ensures consistent learning, and nurtures emotional well-being.

Our program goes beyond education; it fosters meaningful connections and a sense of community. By reaching out in this way, we aim to empower these children, helping them feel valued and included in our larger family.



EYE ON THE FUTURE

Vision Unlimited organized two impactful eye camps focused on promoting eye health and early detection of vision issues among children. The first camp, "Eye on the Future," was held exclusively for 560 children from the Vision Unlimited After School Club. Thereafter, children of the neighbourhood were also checked in their schools. Ms Manisha, Mr Mehboob, and Ms Garima, conducted detailed examinations, including refractions, offered personalized advice, and prescription glasses while also highlighting the importance of regular check-ups, nutrition, and hygiene. The initiative was met with enthusiasm from children and appreciation from parents, and teachers.

In a remarkable effort the team visited 14 schools to provide free eye check-ups to 4,350 underprivileged children. They conducted screenings, distributed educational materials, and prescribed corrective glasses and eyedrops, including referrals when required. Thirty eight children were referred to Marengo Asia Hospital, Gurgaon, for medical management; and two children were referred to AIIMS for cataract surgery.



OUR FRIENDS WHO VISITED US

Our friends from Hero Motor Corp. and Feeding India brought gifts and snacks for the children, and spent a delightful day playing music, and working on art and craft projects.



OUR READING PROGRAM

Our friends from KPMG are now coming regularly to read with, and to, the children in ASC2. We are looking forward to our children learning to read better, and enjoy books- very especially in English.



OUR BRAND NEW SCHOOL SUPPLIES

All our clubs now have water coolers, thanks to the generous support of our partner, Hero MotoCorp. Additionally, air purifiers have been installed in every classroom, ensuring a healthier environment for our children. Access to clean drinking water and pure air is vital for their well-being, especially as Gurgaon faces alarming levels of air pollution.

These upgrades significantly enhance the quality of life for our students, fostering a safe and nurturing learning environment.



DUSSEHRA

PTM

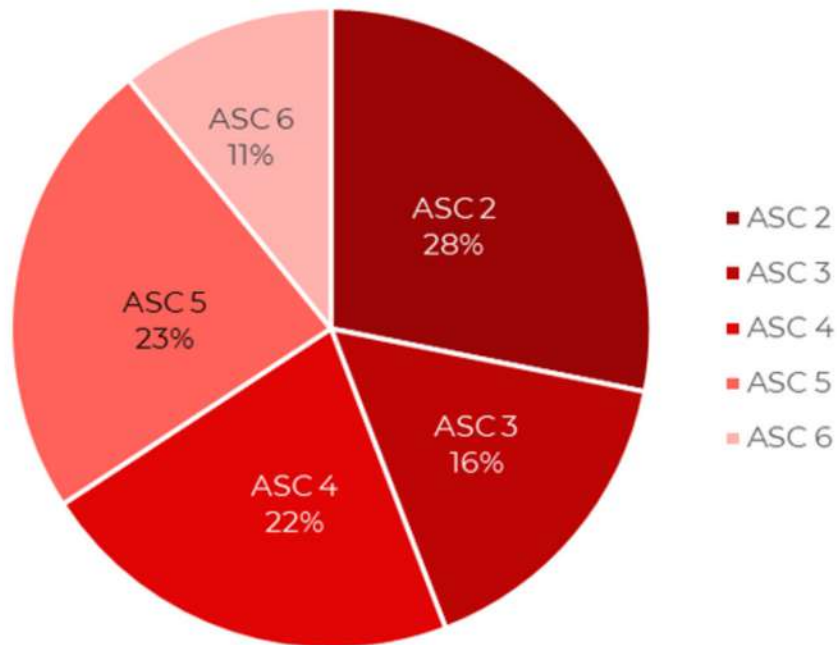

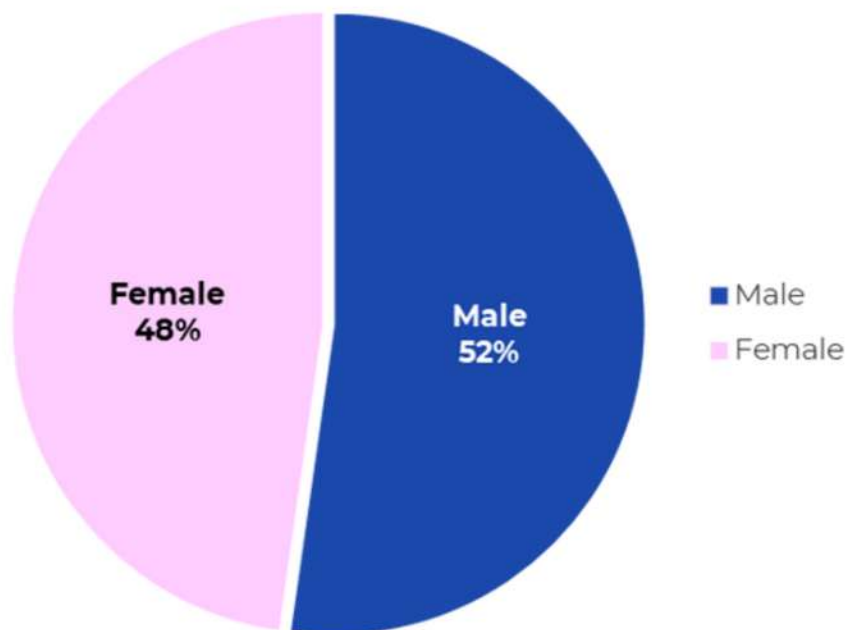


Students & Gender Diversity

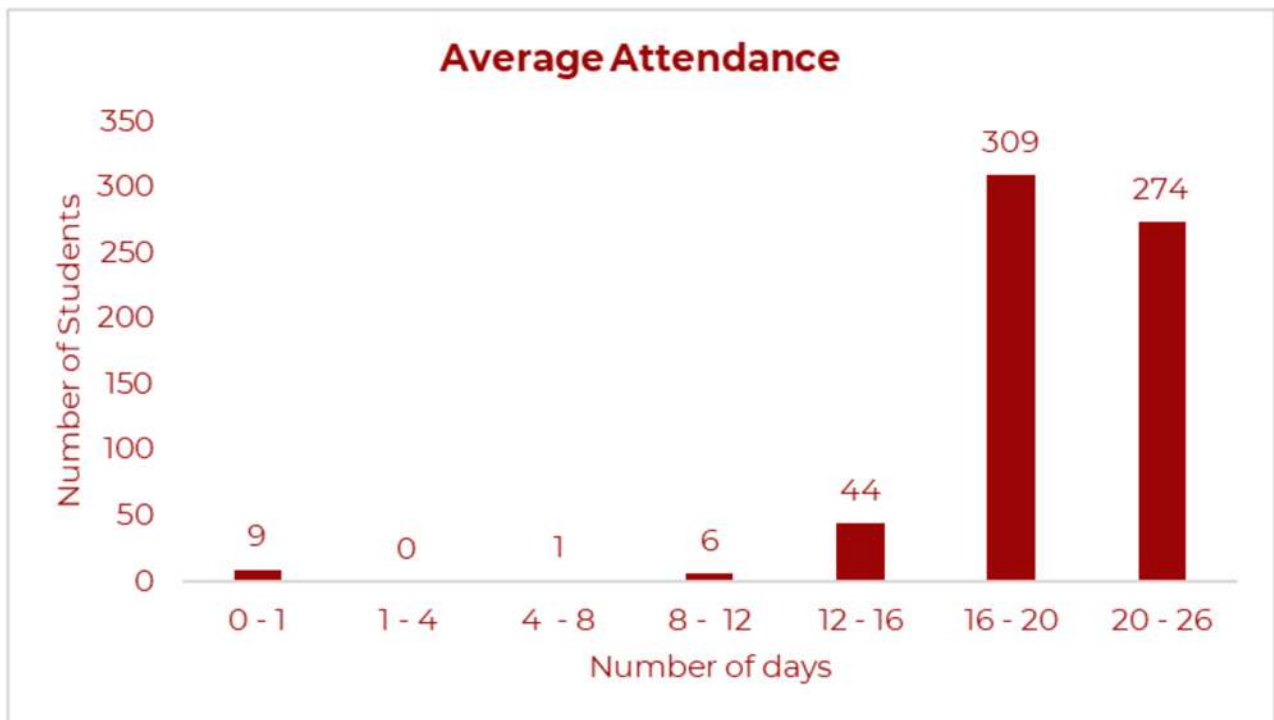
Total Number of Children



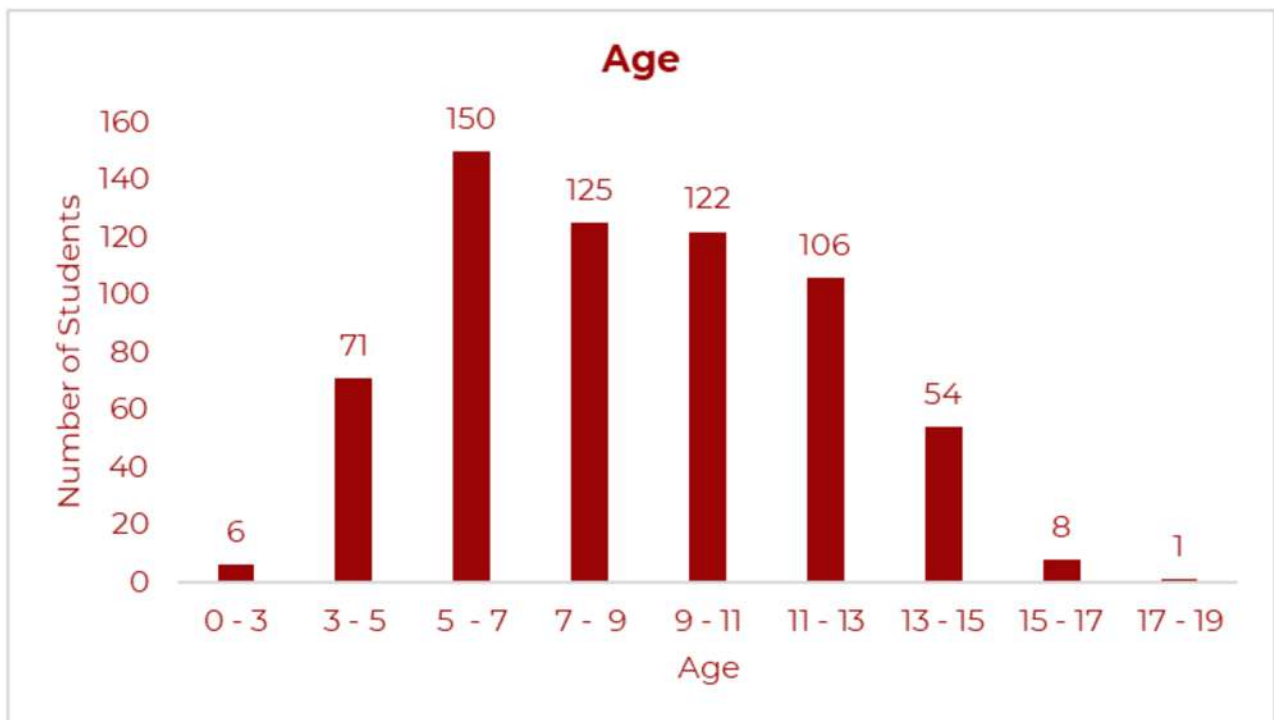
Gender Ratio



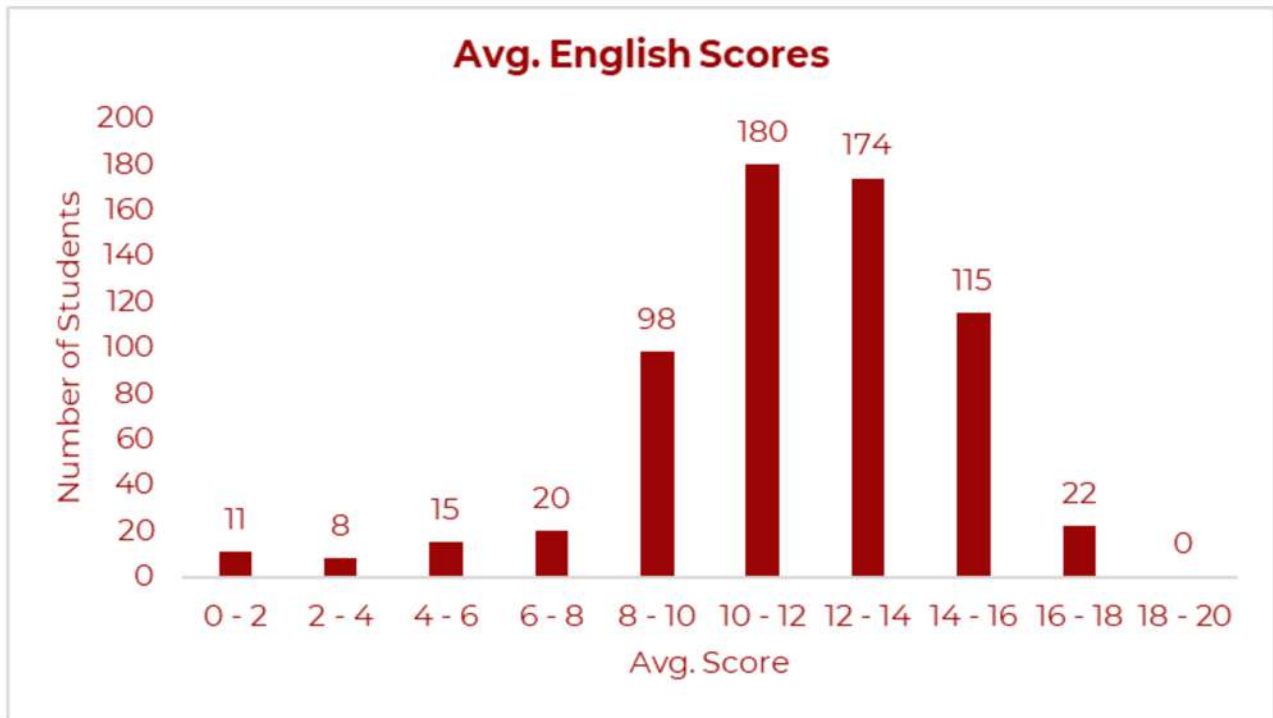

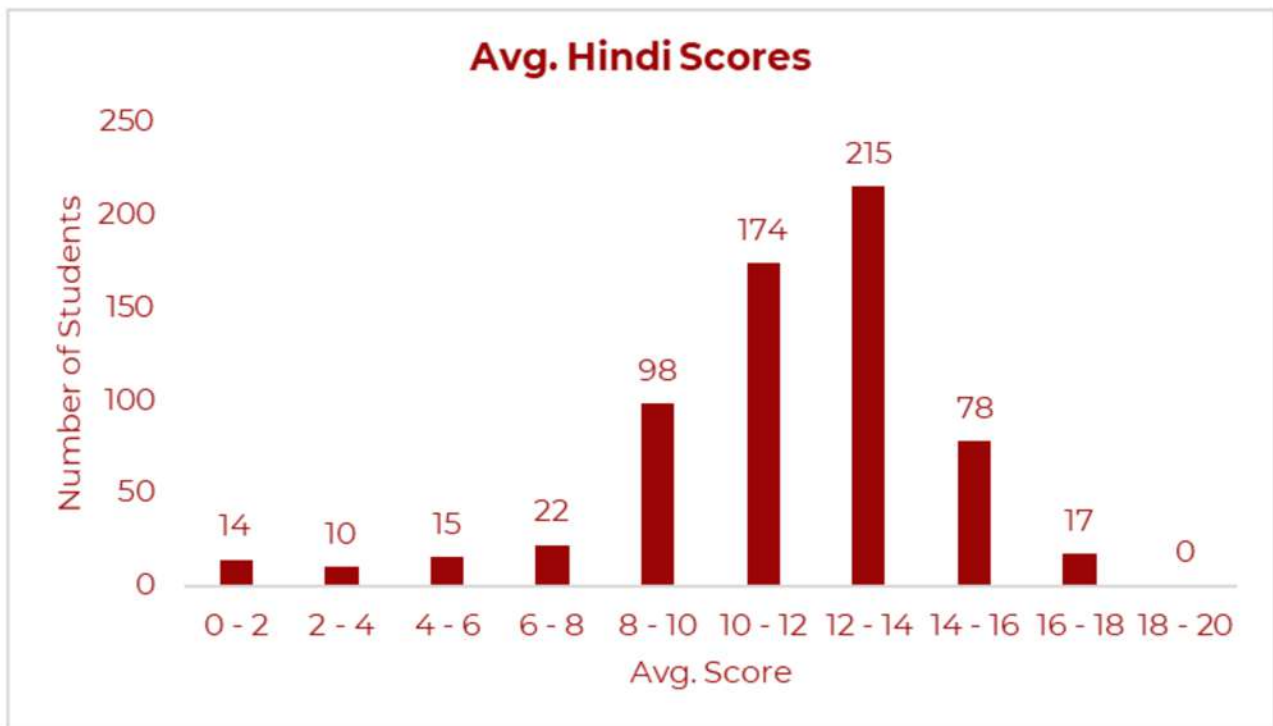

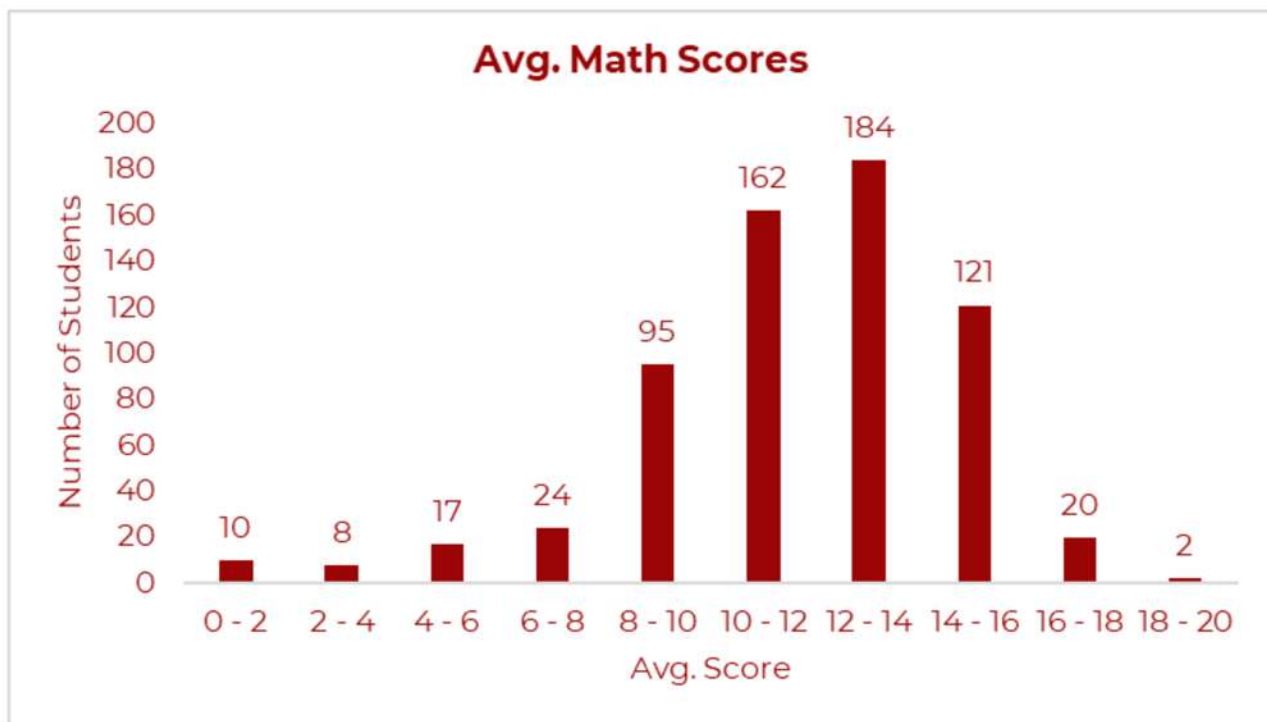
ASSESSMENT - ENGLISH



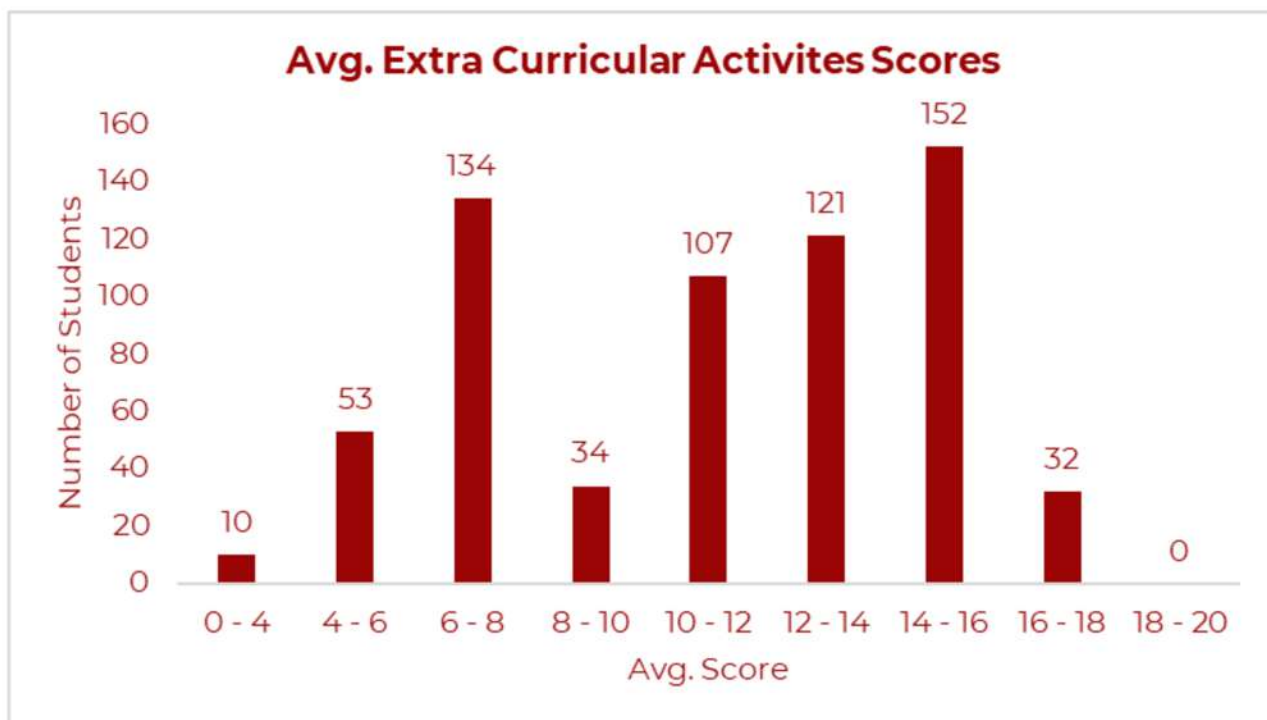
ASSESSMENT - HINDI



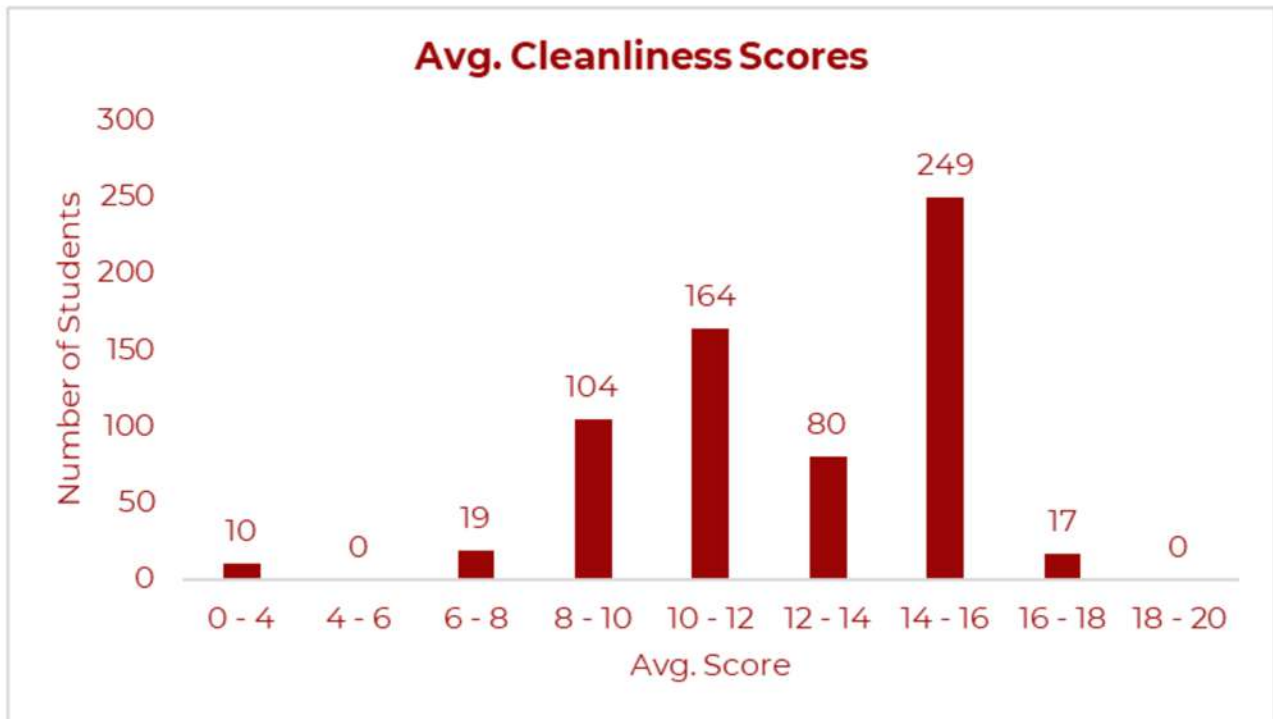
ASSESSMENT - MATH



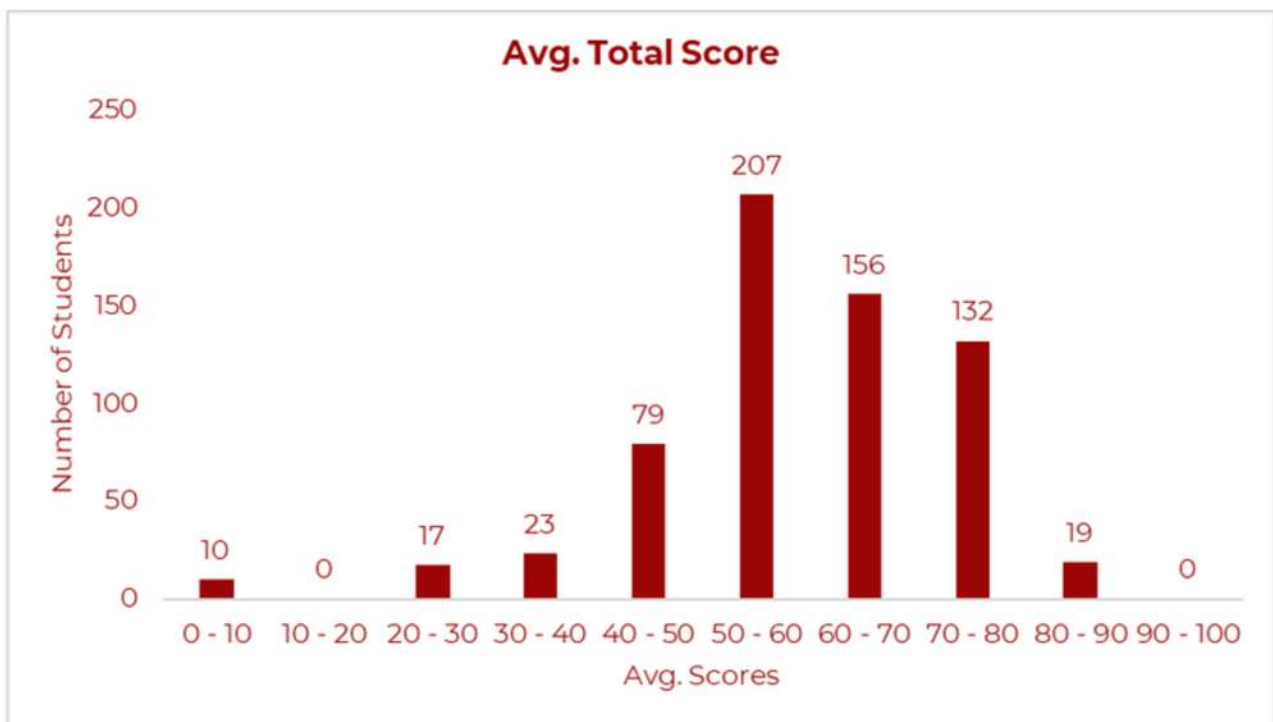
ASSESSMENT - EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES



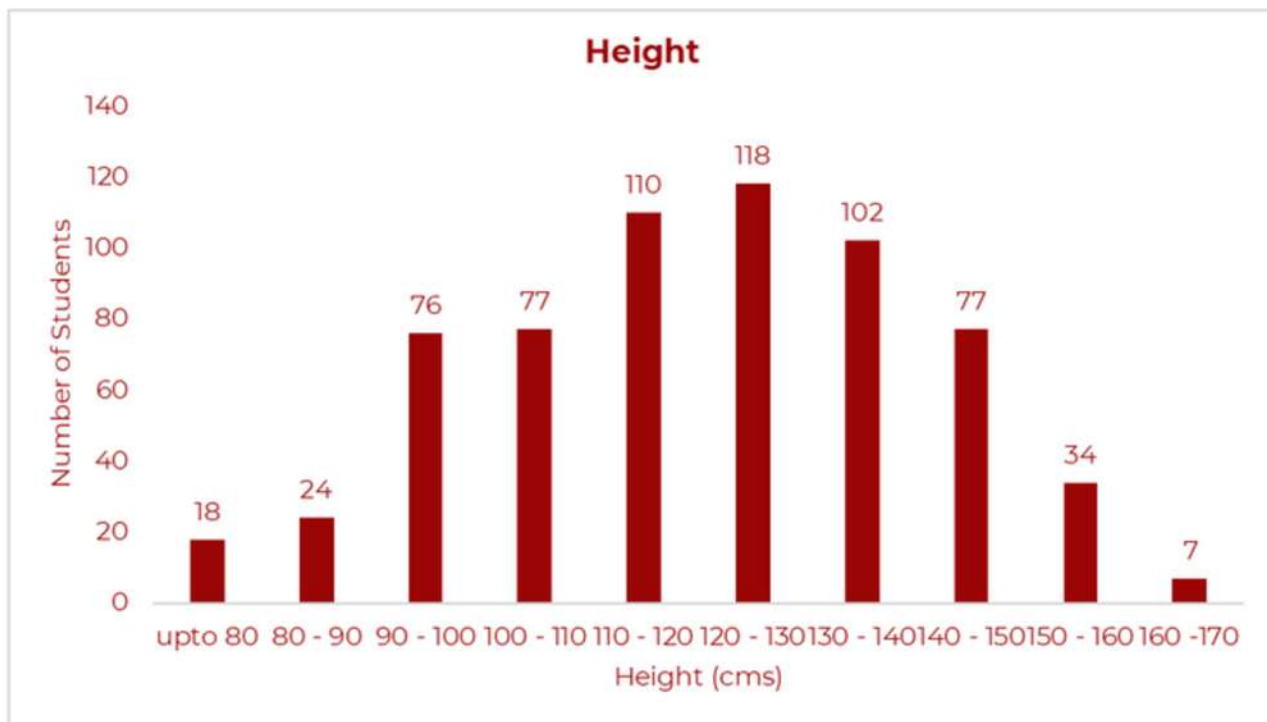
ASSESSMENT - CLEANLINESS



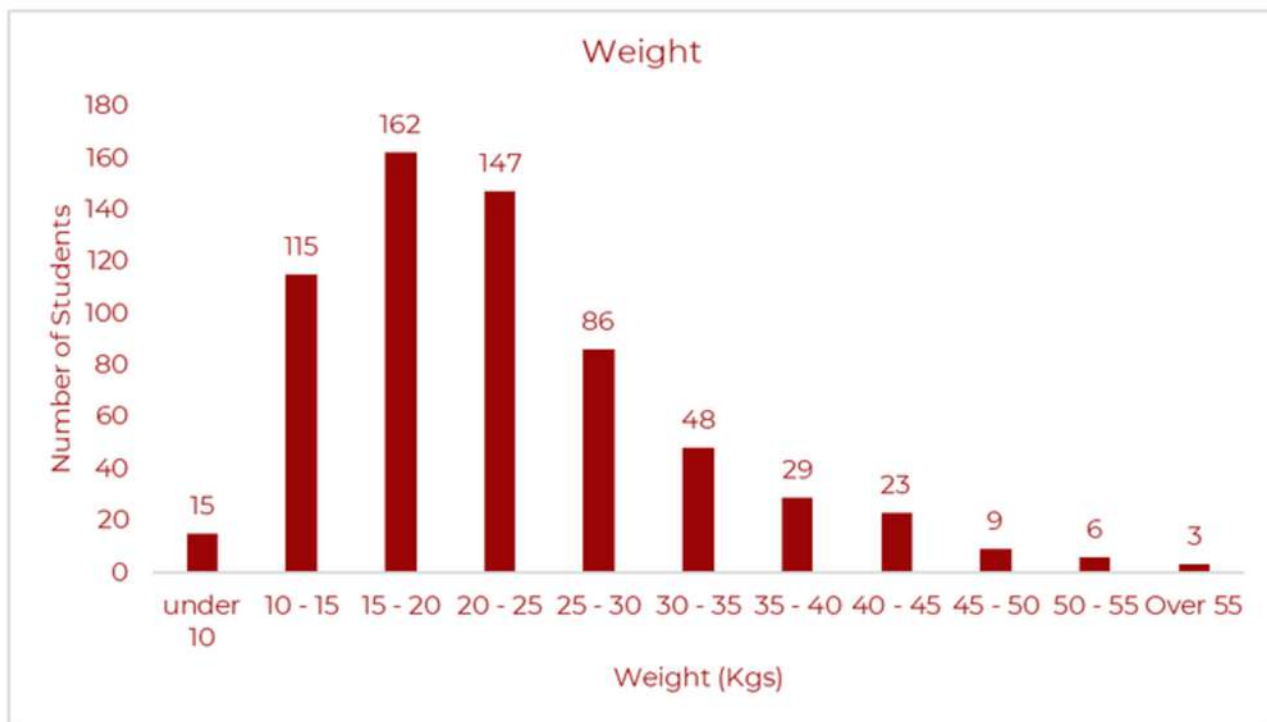
ASSESSMENT - TOTAL SCORE

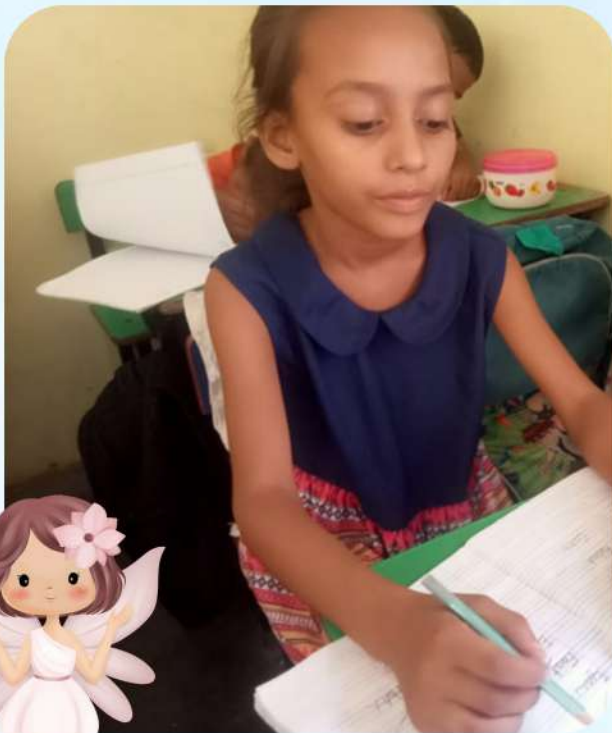
