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INTRODUCTION

The Impact We Wish to Deliver

- Integration, and increased retention of underprivileged students from transitional communities, into the public education system
- Improved health indices (body weight, height, BMI) through meal supplements and regular health check-ups
- Overall personality development through specialized learning programs

What We Do

- **Classroom teaching** in foundational subjects such as English, Hindi, Maths, EVS and Computer science – to reinforce concepts and help students “catch up” to their peers.
- **Nutritional support** with 1 meal a day with minimum of 500 calories, 8 grams of protein, and other vital nutrients.
- **Health check-ups** including anemia testing, immunization support, and eye check ups

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

Holistic development of the child:

- Foundational learning
- Promoting health & immunisation
- Providing nutritional support
- Extracurricular activities
- Safe space for social interaction

Our 'After-School Club' (ASC) program in Gurugram, Haryana, aims to supplement the functioning of the mainstream public education system for underprivileged, transitional communities, by focusing on the following activities.

We work towards helping 'out of school children in developing the basic skills needed for them to be ready to take on formal learning in schools.

We also provide after-school support in the form of doubt clearance and reinforcement of key concepts for children who are already enrolled in government schools.

We essentially incentivise participation and involvement in learning through parent engagement and incentives like the provision of school supplies and learning aids, a meal supplement per day, as well as regular free health check-ups for the holistic development of our children in the urban slums of Badshahpur, Gurugram.

ACADEMICS

Children attending the Vision Unlimited After-School Club demonstrate consistent academic progress. Structured homework support, individualized guidance, and engaging learning activities have significantly strengthened their understanding and performance in core subjects. Teachers have observed noticeable improvements in students' confidence, active classroom participation, and overall enthusiasm for learning.



NUTRITION

Feeding India now provides our children with nutritious hot meals on a daily basis. This collaboration ensures that students are well-nourished, supporting their overall health and well-being while enhancing their ability to learn and succeed academically. Together, we are creating a healthier, more focused, and supportive learning environment.



EXERCISE AND PLAY

Exercise and play play a vital role in keeping children healthy, happy, and active. At the Vision Unlimited After-School Club, we promote enjoyable physical activities that build strength, teamwork, and self-confidence. Through games and movement, children enhance their focus, develop new skills, and grow stronger both physically and mentally. Outdoor play sessions provide opportunities for recreation and social interaction, while morning exercise continues to remain an integral part of our daily curriculum.



GIRLS CIRCLE

The girls come together to openly discuss issues related to adolescence, menstrual health, and other challenges they may face. Teachers serve as facilitators for these discussions, guiding the dialogue, helping identify practical solutions, and supporting the girls in navigating appropriate healthcare services.



CRAFT WORKSHOPS

The clay modeling and painting workshops at Vision Unlimited provided children with hands-on opportunities to express creativity, build self-confidence, and develop essential life skills. The theatre sessions encourage teamwork, communication, and self-expression, while clay art activities stimulated imagination and artistic exploration. Together, these engaging workshops empowered children through joyful and meaningful skill-building experiences.



OUT DOOR DAYS

The outdoor days and free play at Vision Unlimited offered children an engaging platform to express themselves, build confidence, and develop essential life skills. Under the guidance of teachers, these sessions strengthened communication, creativity, and teamwork, while encouraging children to overcome stage fear and express their ideas freely. Through interactive activities and performances, the workshops fostered self-confidence, emotional expression, and a strong sense of collaboration



DANCE CLASSES

Vision Unlimited is happy to share the successful conduct of our Dance Class for school students, designed to promote creativity, confidence, and overall personality development among children from underserved communities. The dance sessions provided students with a joyful and energetic space to express themselves freely. Through guided practice and group choreography, children learned rhythm, coordination, teamwork, and stage confidence. Beyond physical movement, the classes encouraged discipline, focus, and emotional expression. The enthusiasm and smiles on the children's faces reflected the positive impact of the activity. Many students who were initially shy gradually opened up, participating actively and gaining confidence in performing in front of others. Dance has become not just an extracurricular activity but a powerful tool for building self-esteem and reducing stress. Vision Unlimited remains committed to providing holistic development opportunities for children, ensuring they grow not only academically but also creatively and socially.



DAYCARE CENTER

Our after school clubs usually take children above the age of four. But many of our older children are also child minders for their younger siblings, as their mothers go to work. They can, therefore, not attend school.

To help them continue their education, we started a small play area for children even two years old, in the ASCs. We now have forty children in this program. All our ASCs now support our older students by taking care of their younger siblings during school hours.



SPECIAL ABILITIES PROGRAM

SAP is our program for including children with special abilities into our Club. We have twenty children in our family who struggle to come to the Club because of physical, emotional or intellectual limitations. Our teachers visit them twice a week, at home, with little treats, snacks, and teach them at home.

The program is now getting a much needed facelift - Rao Inderjit Singh ji , our Member of Parliament, has given us a comfortable, new car so the children can now come to school instead, and study with their peers!

OUR READING PROGRAM

Our libraries are used regularly. We are looking forward to our children learning to read better, and enjoy books- very especially in English.



ADOLESCENT HEALTH

The Girls Circle Initiative at the Vision Unlimited After-School Club, structured program aimed at empowering adolescent girls from underprivileged communities. The initiative focuses on building self-confidence, leadership qualities, and essential life skills while addressing key topics such as gender equality, menstrual hygiene, health awareness, and personal safety.

Through interactive sessions, group discussions, and mentoring, the program provides a safe and inclusive space for self-expression and peer learning. As a result, participating girls have shown improved communication skills, increased motivation toward education, and greater confidence to make informed decisions—contributing to their holistic growth and long-term empowerment.



GRAND PERENTS HEALTH CAMP

Vision Unlimited successfully organized a health camp for elderly community members, focusing on the well-being of grandparents and senior citizens. The camp aimed to provide basic health check-ups and promote awareness about preventive healthcare.

OLD SCHOOL – SPACE LOCATION

Previously, School was operating in a very small and congested space that lacked cleanliness and basic comfort. The access pathway to the centre was extremely narrow, making it difficult for children to commute safely. Due to limited seating space, students often faced challenges in sitting comfortably during classes. Additionally, there was no adequate open area for recreational activities, restricting opportunities for play and holistic development.

MAKAR SANKRANTI CELEBRATION

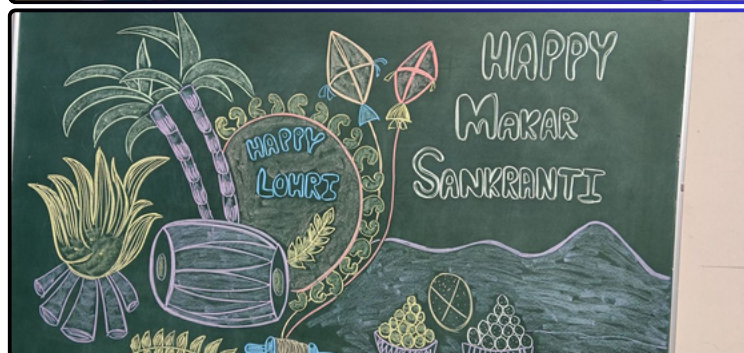

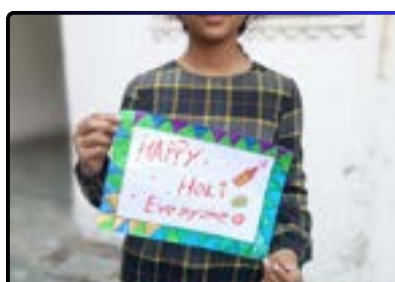
HOLI CELEBRATION

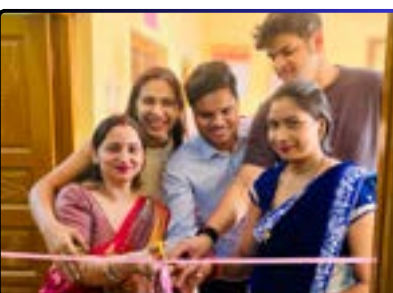

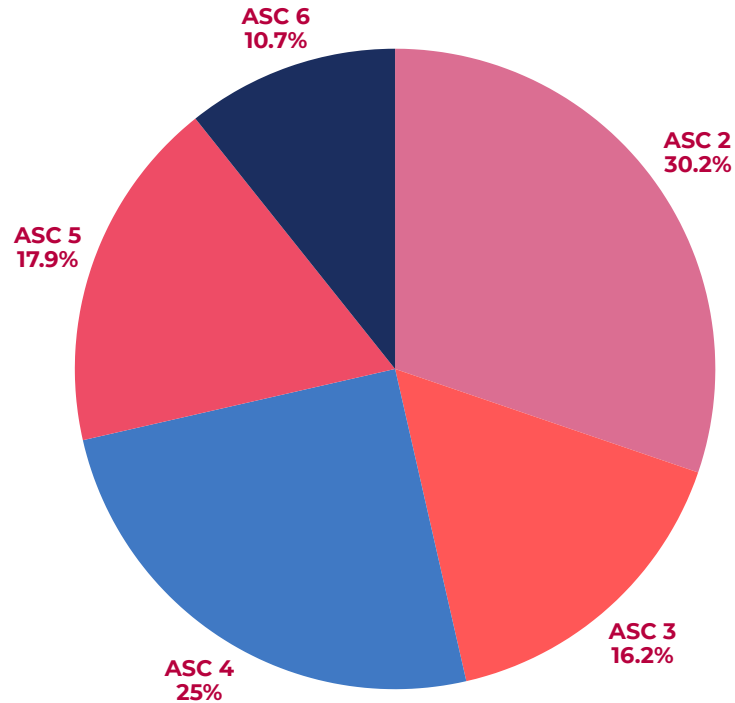

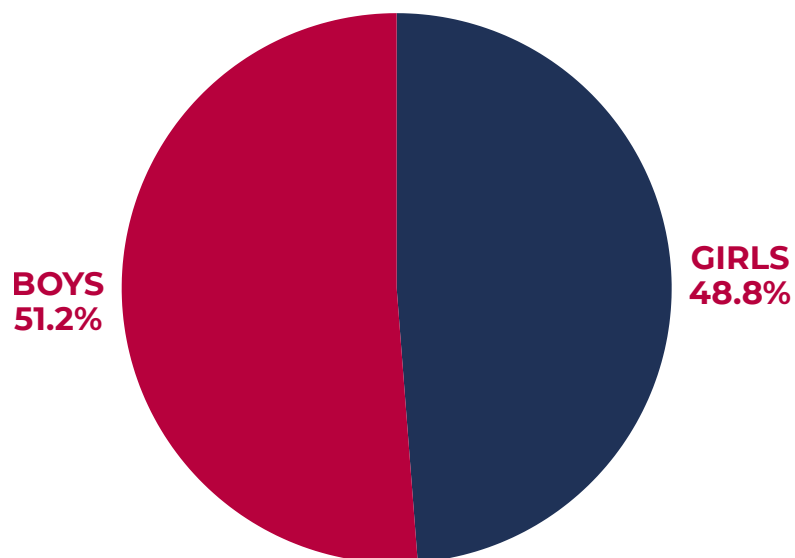


Students & Gender Diversity

TOTAL NUMBER OF STUDENTS

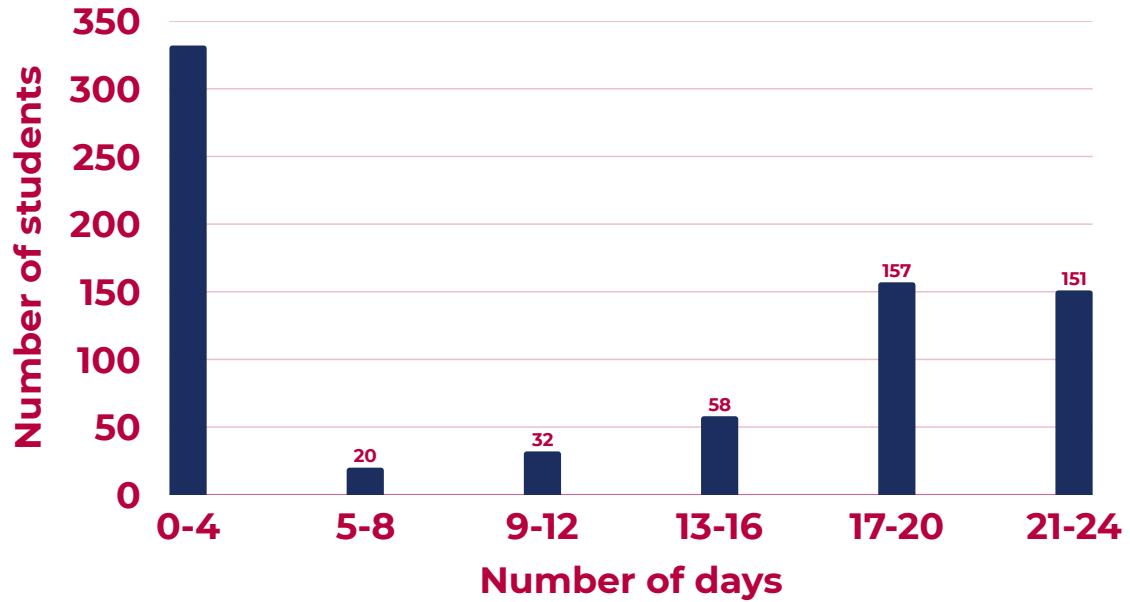


GENDER RATIO



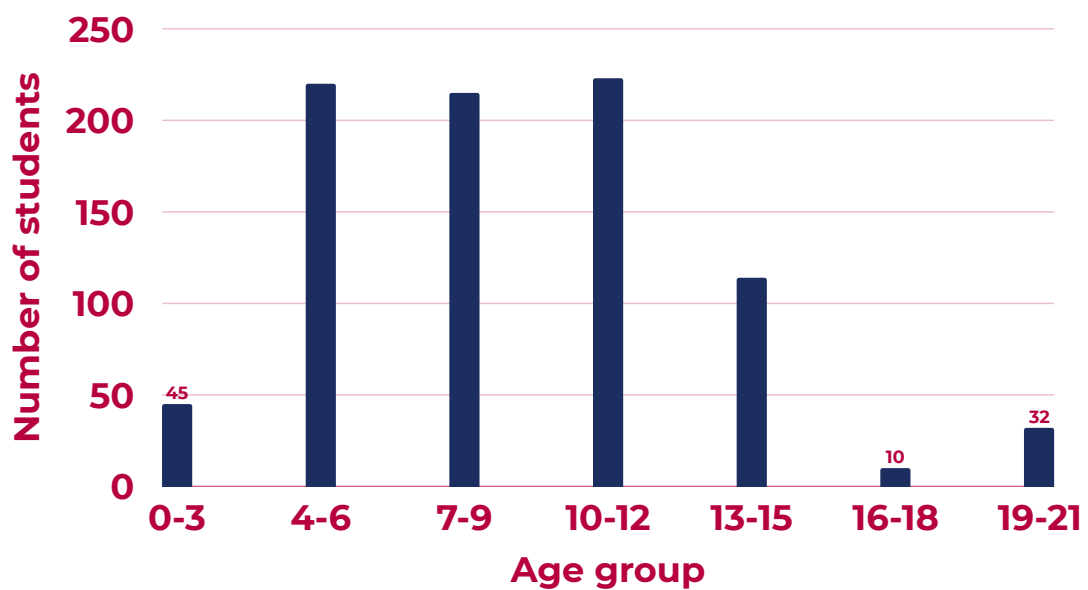

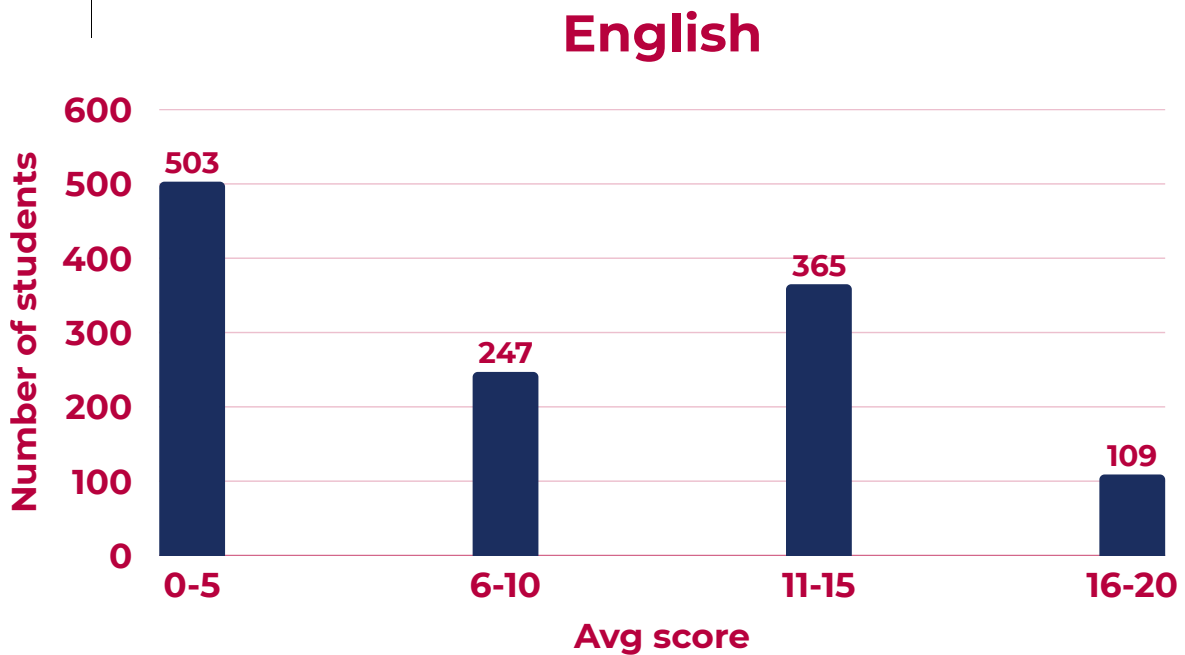

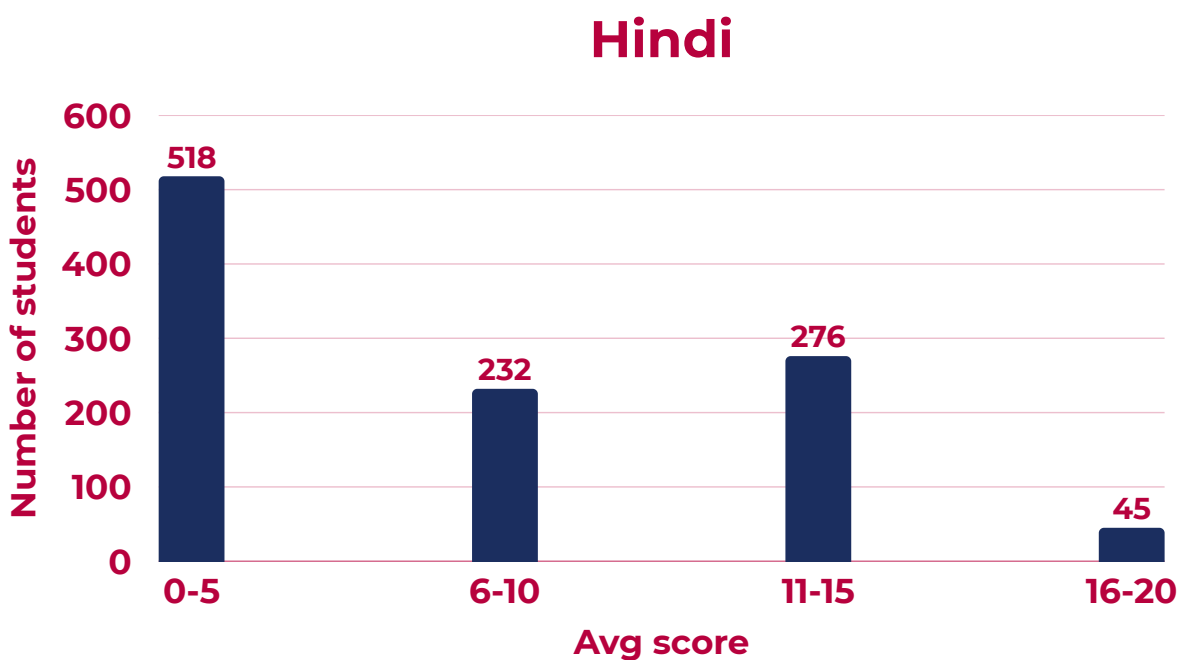

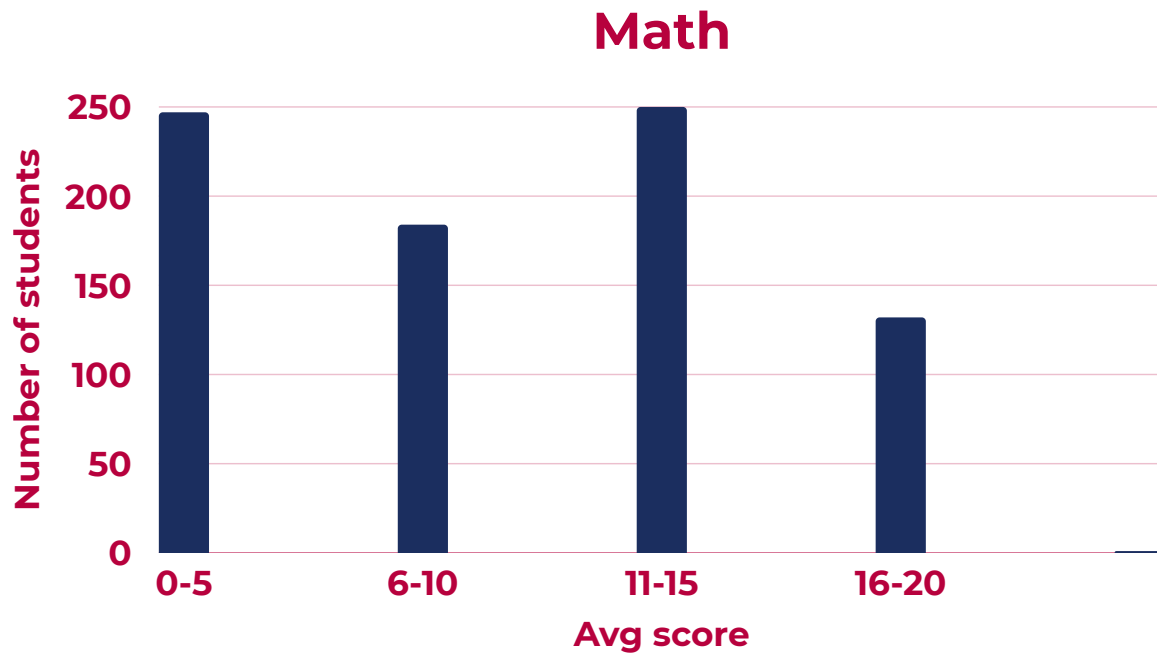

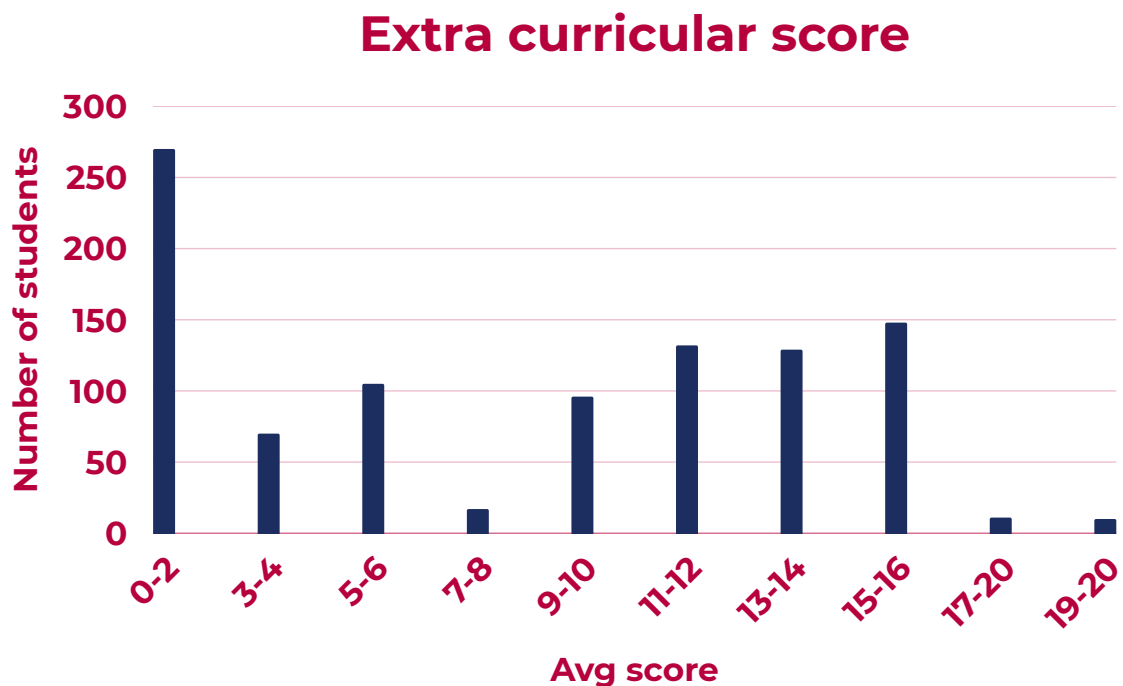
ASSESSMENT - HINDI



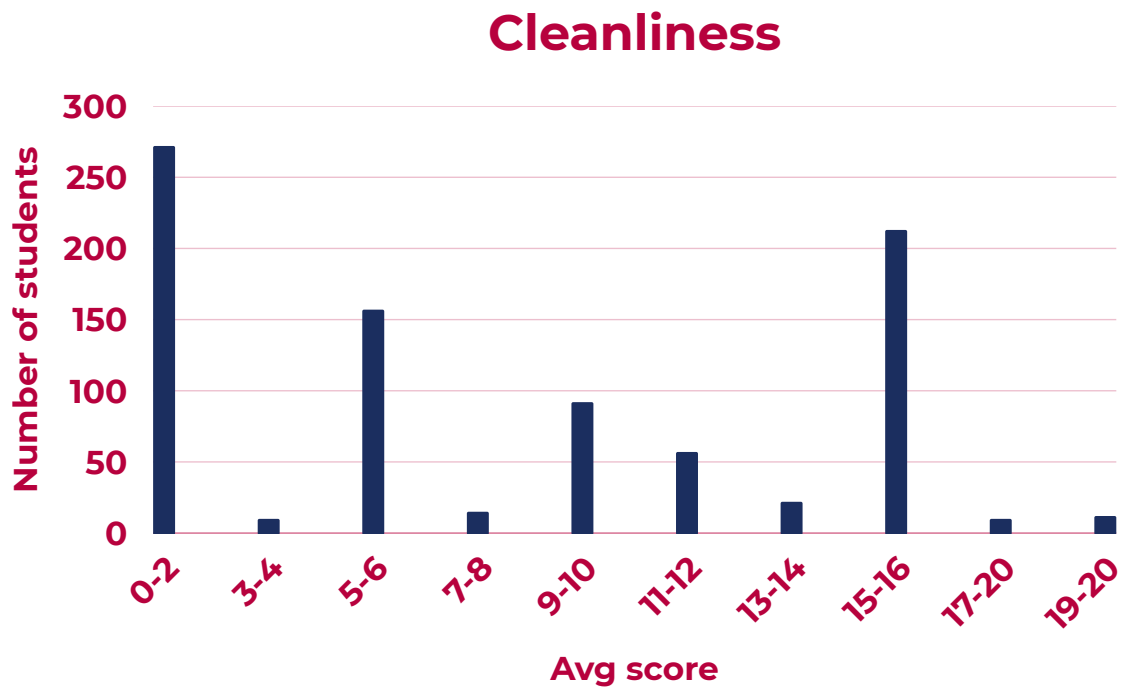
ASSESSMENT - MATH

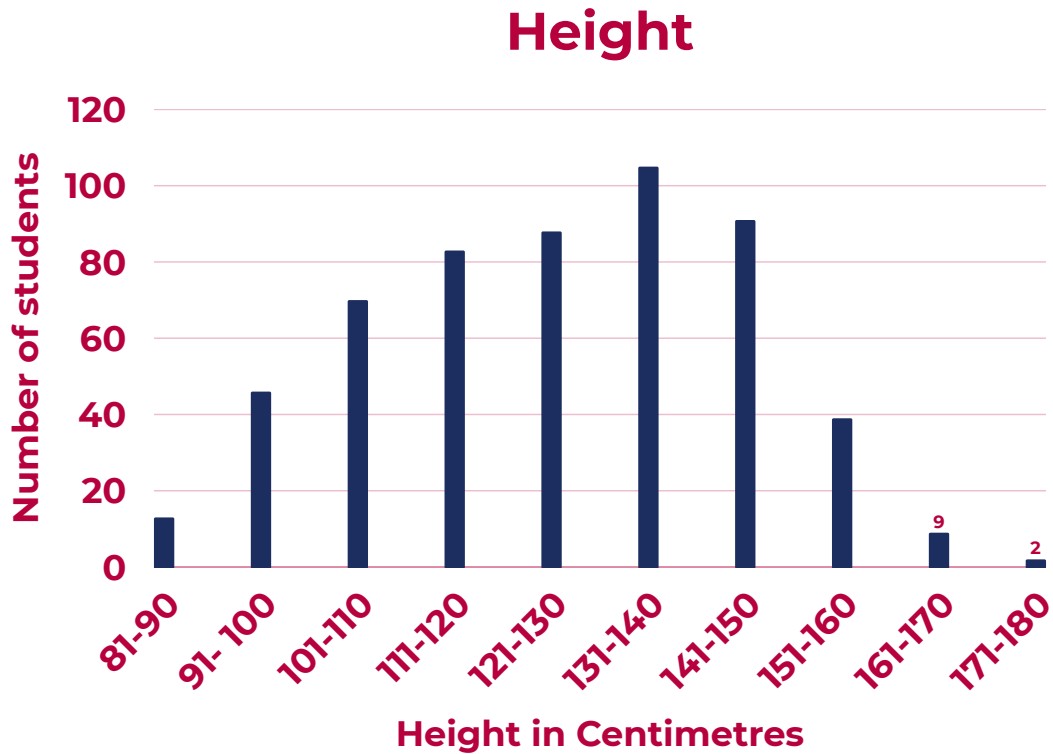

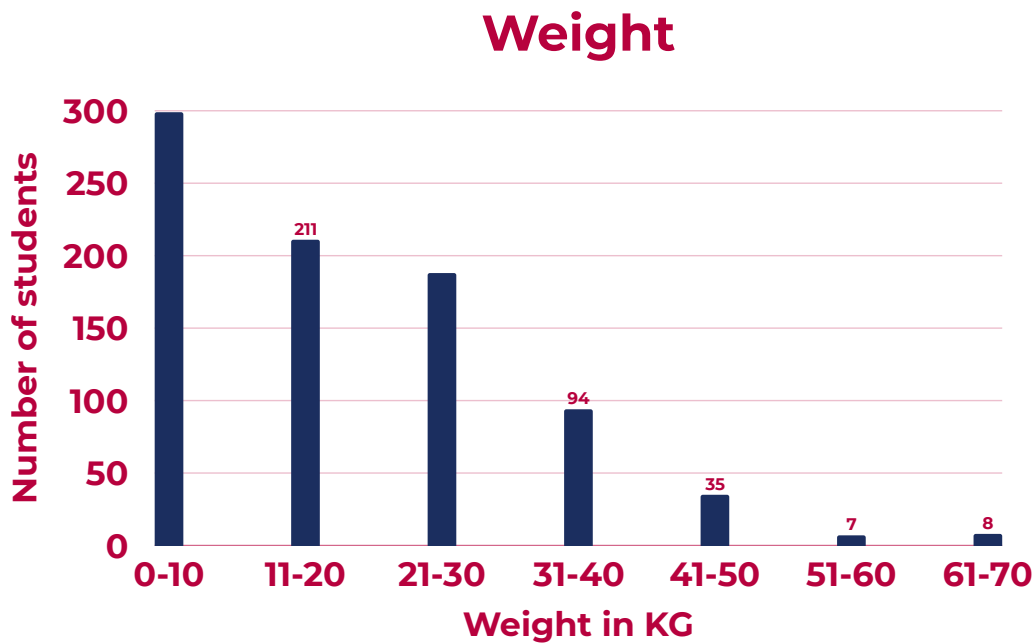
ASSESSMENT - TOTAL SCORE
